

**Virginia WIT State General Meeting Minutes

Meeting was called to order at 12:00 pm by Donny Murray, State President

Reading of the Minutes: Reading of the minutes was waived and accepted as distributed via email to all members.

Treasurer's Report:

Balance forwarded \$5410.29

Books were looked at and will be sent to Donny Murray to be audited. Taxes were filed.

Attendance (as amended): 23 coaches in attendance: Blue Ridge – 4 + 1 guest, Coasters – 2, Tascas – 14 (amended from report of 12 at meeting), Cardinals – 3

Advisory Board Report:

- Suggestion made to get rid of large coffee urns and have chapters bring Kehrigs. Each host club would purchase supplies (sugar, creamer, cups etc) and then request reimbursement from the state.
- State flags – purchase a table set, only use large flags for GNR and State rally. State also needs to purchase a new Virginia State flag
- State Rallies – Suggestion made to keep host chapters in charge of the Rally (have a rally master) but have other chapters help in dividing large duties

State Rally Report:

- 83 coaches registered, expecting closer to 100
- 72 t-shirts ordered
- 171 people (62 first timers) – large group attending from North Carolina and South Carolina
- 12 vendors
- \$22,306 collected
- Golf Carts will be available
- Phil Hanneford sent out letters to new Winnebago owners

Health & Welfare: Jim Alrich with the Tidewater Tascas has a continuing issue with his site and will be selling his coach.

GNR Report: Donnie & Carol Murray were head of row. Daily happy hours, 420 ham sandwiches were made for the row party. We had many Virginia members that were volunteers for the rally. Seminars were very informative, lots of services available. Did not get an indication that WIT club will be disbanded. Big focus on Winnie B's.
